PROGRAM: Tom Stolp is the Executive Director of Ozaukee Washington County Land Trust. He presented a powerpoint presentation on Conserving Cedar Gorge Clay Bluffs. The OWLT was started in 1992. The land trust was established to preserve open spaces, farmland, wooded land and waterways in Ozaukee and Washington County. So far 30 preserves have been established. They are affordable for everyone since no admission fees are charged. At this time, the organization is trying to raise 5 million dollars to preserve the 130 acre Cedar Gorge Clay Bluffs. The bluffs are adjacent to the 70 acre Lions Den Preserve on Lake Michigan. Prior to joining OWLT, Tom worked in Wisconsin's conservation community advancing legislation and policies to protect natural resources.
